

OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

Overnight parking permits are valid in Lot #3 only.

In addition to abiding by the Pierce Law Parking Policy, individuals assigned Overnight Permits must:

- 1. Submit an Overnight Parking Permit Application for each semester that overnight parking is needed to the Registrar by the deadlines listed in the Pierce Law Parking Policy
- 2. Pay a \$75 per semester parking permit fee
- 3. Visibly affix the Pierce Law parking permit to the lower left rear window of the vehicle.
- 4. Park head in along the fences immediately to the right & left of the entrance in parking Lot #3
- 5. Notify the Registrar of any changes to your contact information
- 6. Quickly move the vehicle upon request for snow removal, etc.

Cars not adhering to these guidelines will be towed at owner's expense.
